## Senior Infants 2017/2018- Booklist

### ENGLISH READERS

A large bank of graded reading material is purchased centrally by the school for Senior Infants. The children do not purchase individual 'core readers'. All children pay €10 directly to the school for this scheme. This is excellent value for money – it would not be possible, in economic terms, for each child to purchase the vast quantity of books to which they will have access through this scheme.

### Please Remember:

- Parents are responsible for the purchase of school books (other than those that relate to the 'Book Rental Scheme')
- Pupils are required to have the books for Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> August
- Please ensure that books purchased by child are marked with the child's name on the outside cover and on the first page.
- Children are responsible for their own pencils

### **Educational Costs Contribution: €140**

For everyone's convenience, the school directly pays specific costs that relate to each child in the school – these include costs re personal accident insurance, photocopying, P.E workshops, contribution to ICT expenses (software etc.) to name but a few. To reimburse the school for these costs and to make it possible to continue to provide these important services and facilities, **the Educational Contribution of €140 falls due in the first week of September.** An ePayment facility for these costs will be available from late August 2017. Alternatively, payment can be made by cash or cheque via the secretary's office. (Note: while it is very helpful for the school if this is paid during the first week of September, we acknowledge that some may wish to defer payment until mid-October when the 'typically expensive' month of September has passed. As in previous years, paying the educational contribution and voluntary additional contribution together has tax benefits for the school – we will circulate further information about this in September. In the meantime, please contact the secretary's office if you have any queries).

Remittance form for contribution will be forwarded to each family by e-mail. Additionally, a hard copy is available from the secretary's office on request.
