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Education enrichment projects

Over the past number of years the parents association have aimed to enrich the primary school experience for students of Scoil San Treasa. In 2017 we put to use an 'incubator' bought for the school by the out-going 6th class students and undertook the task of incubating eggs and hatching chicks. This summer we purchased butterfly kits and set up a display in the school foyer. Our parents association 'butterfly expert' upskilled on all things butterfly and brought each class along to the display during school hours to explain the various stages of the butterfly life cycle. I'm sure many of you witnessed the fascinated little faces peering in at these butterfly nets every morning before school waiting for the new stage of the butterfly life cycle. Eventually, we saw the much-anticipated butterflies hatching from their chrysalis and gaining strength in their wings. The highlight of the project was a butterfly release ceremony in the grounds of the school. This, we hope, was a wonderfully memorable and enriching experience for our students. Teachers also got on board with the project and created butterfly themed art work with their classes all of which added to the butterfly theme in the school foyer and hallways.
