Section 3: Payment:

Educational Costs – Contribution: €140

For everyone's convenience, the school directly pays specific costs that relate to each child in the school – these include costs re personal accident insurance, photocopying, P.E. teachers, workshops, contribution to Digital Learning expenses to name but a few. To reimburse the school for these costs and to make it possible to continue to provide these important services and facilities, we ask that the Educational Contribution of €140 is submitted to the school by the second week of September. This can be paid via e payment. *(Note: While it is very helpful in terms of the smooth running of the school if this is paid during the second week in September, we acknowledge that some may wish to defer making this contribution until mid-October when the 'typically expensive' month of September has passed.)* As in previous years, submitting the educational contribution and voluntary contribution together with a CHY3 Cert generates tax refund benefits for the school – we will circulate further information about this in the new school year. In the meantime, please contact the secretary's office via email secretary@sstreasa.ie - if you have any queries. Remittance form for contribution will be forwarded to each family by email. Additionally, a hard copy will be available from the secretary's office on request.
